# Itinerary for Exploring Tezpur, Tawang, Bumla and Sela Pass

### Day 1: Arrival in Tezpur

- **Morning**: Arrive in Tezpur, the gateway to Arunachal Pradesh. Explore local attractions like Agnigarh Hill and Mahabhairab Temple.

- Afternoon: On the way back, visit Sangetsar Lake (Madhuri Lake) for its tranquil surroundings.
- **Evening**: Return to Tawang and relax.

## Day 6: Tawang to Tezpur (330 km | ~10-11 hours)

- Morning: Begin the journey back to Tezpur, retracing the scenic route via Sela Pass and Dirang.
- **Evening**: Reach Tezpur, enjoy a relaxed evening, and prepare for departure.
