Day 1: Leh – The Journey Begins

• Evening:

Explore the city's cultural landmarks, such as Raghunath Temple and Mubarak
Mandi Palace, to understand Jammu's historical role as a strategic hub.

Day 4: Jammu → Poonch

Morning:

 Drive to Poonch (approx. 240 km, 6–7 hours), a key region during the 1971 war for its proximity to the border.

• Afternoon:

 Visit the **Poonch Fort**, which served as a strategic outpost during various conflicts. • Pay respects at the **1971 War Memorial**, dedicated to the soldiers who defended this region.

• Evening:

• Reflect on the resilience of the people of Poonch amidst decades of conflict.

Day 5: Poonch → Uri

Morning:

o Drive to Uri (approx. 240 km, 7–8 hours).

• Afternoon:

- Visit the **Uri War Memorial**, commemorating the valor of soldiers during the 1971 war.
- Explore the Jhelum River Valley, which witnessed significant troop movements and skirmishes.

• Evening:

• Interact with local residents to hear stories of how the 1971 war shaped the region.

Day 6: Uri → Kargil

Morning:

Drive to Kargil via Srinagar and Drass (approx. 280 km, 9–10 hours).
