

# 1 Day Itinerary - Munabao

## Morning

- **Arrival in Munabao:** Start your day early by arriving in Munabao, a small village located near the India-Pakistan border, around 120 km from Jaisalmer.
- **Visit the Munabao Railway Station:** Begin your day by visiting the **Munabao Railway Station**, which is significant for being the last station on the Indian side of the border on the Jaisalmer-Barmer railway line. This station has historical significance, as it was part of the famous **Samjhauta Express** route that used to run between India and Pakistan.

- **Explore the Border Area:** Visit the nearby **border outpost** area to get a glimpse of the India-Pakistan border. While direct access to the border might not always be possible, you can enjoy the surrounding landscapes and learn about the strategic importance of the region.
- **Local Culture and Village Life:** Take a stroll through the village of Munabao, interacting with the locals and learning about the rural life of Rajasthan. You may come across local artisans and traditional Rajasthani crafts.

## Afternoon

- **Lunch:** Enjoy a traditional Rajasthani meal at a local eatery or guesthouse. You can try dishes like **dal baati churma**, **gatte ki sabzi**, and **ker sangri**.
- **Visit Nearby Historical Sites:** After lunch, take a short drive to nearby **Kuldhara Village**, an abandoned village with a mysterious history, or **Tanot Mata Temple** (if time permits), which is located about 100 km away and has historical significance related to the 1965 and 1971 wars.

## Evening

- **Desert Exploration:** Head out for a desert safari or camel ride in the nearby **Thar Desert**. The desert landscape is peaceful and perfect for a quiet retreat.
- **Sunset Viewing:** Find a vantage point to enjoy the stunning sunset over the desert. The golden sands and the changing hues of the sky create a breathtaking view.
