Turtuk Itinerary

Day 1: Leh to Turtuk (205 km, 7-8 hours)

- Morning: Begin your journey from Leh early in the morning, heading towards Nubra Valley. You
 will drive through the Khardung La Pass, one of the highest motorable roads in the world,
 offering breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains.
- **Midday**: Stop for lunch in **Diskit**, the main town of Nubra Valley. Visit the **Diskit Monastery** if time permits, offering panoramic views of the valley and the statue of Maitreya Buddha.
- Afternoon: After lunch, continue your drive to Turtuk, which is located about 84 km from Diskit.
 The journey to Turtuk takes you through beautiful landscapes, with scenic views of mountains, rivers, and fields.
- **Evening**: Arrive in **Turtuk** by late afternoon. Check into a guesthouse or homestay, where you will get a glimpse of the local Balti culture. Take a short walk around the village, which is nestled by the Shyok River, and enjoy the peaceful environment.
- **Night**: Overnight stay in Turtuk.

Day 2: Explore Turtuk and Surroundings

- Morning: After breakfast, explore Turtuk Village, which is divided into two parts: the old village
 and the new settlement. The village is famous for its traditional Balti architecture, colorful houses,
 and terraced fields.
- **Midday**: Visit the **Turtuk Monastery**, a small but important religious site for the locals. The monastery offers a serene atmosphere and great views of the surrounding mountains and valley.
- **Afternoon**: Take a walk to the **Turtuk Gardens**, where you can see orchards of apricots, apples, and other fruits. Turtuk is known for its agricultural richness due to the irrigation systems brought by the Shyok River.
- **Evening**: Spend time interacting with the local Balti people, who have a distinct culture and language influenced by their historical ties to Pakistan. You can learn about their traditions, music, and local handicrafts.
- Night: Overnight stay in Turtuk.

Day 3: Return Journey to Leh

- Morning: After breakfast, take one last walk around Turtuk to enjoy the peaceful surroundings.
 You can also visit the War Memorial dedicated to the soldiers who fought in the 1971 Indo-Pak
 war
- Midday: Start your journey back towards Leh. On the way, stop at Sumur and visit the Sumur Monastery or take a detour to see the Panamik Hot Springs, where you can relax in the natural hot water pools.
- **Afternoon**: Continue your journey back through the Nubra Valley. Take a short break at **Diskit** to capture any last photos of the area and enjoy the surroundings.
- **Evening**: Arrive back in **Leh** by evening, marking the end of your Turtuk Valley trip.
